Support for the Ukraine

Pastor Zygmunt Karel (Insight for Living Ministries Poland) - Ukraine Update

On 24th February 2022, Russian military forces began attacking major cities across Ukraine with millions of people fleeing Ukraine into neighbouring countries including Poland, which has received the most refugees - topping

9 million. Many of these refugees have since moved to other countries, but around 2 million currently remain.



Pastor Zygmunt, his wife Maria, and the team at IFLM Poland has partnered with other churches and organisations to alleviate agonising pain created by the war and to extend

biblical hope and compassion to those who are desperate for comfort and light.

IFLM Poland helps support more than 70 refugees,

mostly women and children, by giving them long-term housing and daily necessities like food and clothing. Furthermore, IFLM Poland has helped sustain more than 350 families by delivering goods across

the border into Lutsk. The war is likely, no longer at the forefront of people's minds outside of Eastern Europe, but it remains an ongoing humanitarian crisis on the doorsteps of many in this part of the world.

Branch FM continues to broadcast Pastor Zygmunt's daily message in Polish weekdays at 11pm and it has been a real opportunity for our Polish listeners to hear daily the teaching of the Gospel shared by Pastor Zygmunt. Please continue to uphold in your prayers Zygmunt and his team over in Poland.

Studio Move

Due to circumstances beyond our control in January we had to relocate our studio which is on a temporary basis to Eurovision Mission to Europe building based in Dewsbury. We were grateful and blessed by that Ministry who opened their doors to us at short notice providing office space and accommodation to house one of the studios. It is good to be working alongside a super Christian organisation that has been serving and ministering to Eastern Europe for many years. Plans are afoot to build new purpose-built studios for Branch FM and we will keep you updated on our progress.



Featured Interview

Malcolm Ryan

Q: How did you become involved with BFM?

It was back in November 2010 that I contacted Branch FM's station director Steve regarding Words for Life, a daily devotional series I was putting together. Steve responded positively, something he's continued to do ever since. And his ongoing encouragement has led to me developing more programmes for the station, including The Weekend Show, The Country Show, Easy Does It and Just Jazz and Blues. Then I must just add a word of appreciation for Barnabas at Branch FM, who has also been very helpful over the years.

Q: How and when did you become a Christian?

It was during Easter 1981 that I asked Jesus to be my Lord and Saviour, and my wife Clare did the same a few weeks later. To cut a long story short, during the year before, God had worked in the lives

of Clare and I in some remarkable ways and had seen to it that our twins Gary and Carol were born safely, despite Clare frequently being subject to epileptic seizures. As for the means that God used to bring us to himself, it was essentially through understanding the gospel as we read two books: Billy Graham's 'Peace with God' and Brother David's 'God's Smuggler to China'.

Q: What is or was your day-to-day job and what did it involve?

At the time of my decision to follow Christ, I worked in operator services at British Telecom.

Q: Away from radio what are some of your favourite past times?

I love getting out into the garden. Having moved last year, we have a large garden that's at present a bit of a blank canvas (mainly grass, paving and shingle!), so Clare and I are enjoying a few visits to the local garden centre to choose some suitable plants. With six lively grandchildren, we also enjoy family get-togethers.

Q: Would you share some of the other Ministry work you have done in the past or are doing now?



For ten years, I was pastor of a Baptist church in Norfolk. That kept me quite busy! Nowadays, well into my 'retirement', I tend to concentrate ministry efforts on providing programmes for Branch FM and another Christian and community radio station based in Liverpool.


Q: Are there any funny moments when you have been on the radio or in your other Ministry?
